What techniques can we employ to utilize natural resources in a way that respects and nurtures our ecosystems? Together, we will work on pieces that challenge conventional notions of design, exploring how we can create textiles which are rooted in a commitment to sustainability and present these during fashion revolution week.

Join me for a learning experience, where you will gain practical skills in natural dyeing alongside a deeper understanding of the role designers play in fostering social and environmental change.
